12 - 18 DOG LIMIT (Weather permitting). Minimum of 12 runs will be offered. If it's **HOT** we will run some in the morning, take a break and run remaining runs in the evening. If the weather is cool we can take 18 runs and run straight through. A waiting list will be maintained after 12 runs. Order of draw & waiting list per ASCA rules. Maximum of 18 runs total.

25 Minute time limit with a 10 minute and a 5 minute time warning 10 head of Barbados Sheep per run There will not be a "set out" dog. Ties will be broken by Pasture Work

Entry Fee: \$60 per run

Entries: Pre-entries will not be accepted if postmarked **BEFORE August 10th**. Pre-entries must be post marked no later than Midnight, August 19, 2017. No Refunds after the **August 19th Deadline**.

Entries will not be drawn until after closing date. All entrants will be notified before the trial if they drew into the trial **or** if they are on the waiting list. (Please note: the number of entries will be determined by the weather)

<u>Day of trial</u> entries may be taken if trial has not filled or until 7:00a.m. on September 23rd, whichever is first.

Bitches in season will run in order & must be crated when not competing.

Run order will be determined by drawing prior to the trial by the trial committee.

Awards: 1-4th place

Ranch Sheep Trial Described order of Tasks

- 1. From south end of sheep arena **Gather** 10 head of sheep and fetch or drive to bring them through the gate into the **40 acre pasture**.
- 2. In **Pasture** fetch or drive sheep up the hill, around the dead log and then put the sheep back into the sheep arena.
- 3. Move sheep from arena into **PEN A**
- 4. From **PEN A** and go to Bow-gate and sort 5 marked sheep into **PEN B**. Move 5 sorted sheep through **PEN B** and pen into **PEN C**
- 5. Move 5 remaining sheep from PEN A into arena and pen into PEN C
- 6. From **PEN C** move all 10 head of sheep and load up the **chute** closing the back drop gate and front stop gate on the first 4 head in chute. Read one ear tag number for the judge. Open the front & back of the chute and push all 10 head through **chute** into **PEN A**.
- 7. Move 10 head from **PEN A** into arena and **Exhaust** into **PEN D** DONE.

From the Stockdog Rules, Chapter 19.6 **Qualifying score** would be 75 or more points out of a possible 100. The scoresheet is broken down as follows:

- a. Pen Work 20 points
- b. Sort Work 20 points
- c. Chute Work 20 points
- d. Pasture Work 40 points
