# Frog's Breath Herding Ranch Dog Trial Sheep (HRDs)

## October 20, 21, 22, 2017

### STARTING SET UP:

- Livestock will be held in adjoining Fields and Pens without visibility screens.
- The course will begin and must end with five sheep in Pens E, G, I, J and the Round Pen. All groups of sheep will be marked so they are identifiable as a set.
- All gates will be closed.

### GENERAL RULES:

- Time 20 minutes.
  - All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
  - Sheep will be held off all gates while the gate is being opened except for the sort in Pen I.
  - Exercise "1. Small Pen Work," will break ties. 2<sup>nd</sup> tie breaker will be exercise "3. Drive and Obstacle 1." 3<sup>rd</sup> tie breaker will be Time.
1. **SMALL PEN WORK - 25 pts.:** Time begins when the gate into Pen K is opened. Move the sheep from Pen J into Pen K; move the sheep from Pen I into Pen J; move the sheep from Pen G into Pen I; move the sheep from Pen E into Pen I; move the sheep from the Round Pen into Pen E. Dog and Handler will now enter Pen I. Exercise ends when the gate into Pen I is closed.
  2. **SORT - 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the gate into Pen I is closed. Gate sort the sheep you removed from Pen E into Pen G. The exercise ends when the gate between Pens I and G is closed.
  3. **DRIVE, OBSTACLE 1 - 25 pts.:** The exercise begins when the gate between Pen I and G is closed. Using the alleyway go into Field 5. Remove the sheep from Pen K. Drive them across Field 5, through Obstacle 1 and then behind the panels next to the road. Leave the sheep behind these panel. The exercise ends when the sheep are behind the panel.
    - **HRD I** may accompany the sheep thought-out this exercise.
    - **HRD II** stays in the marked area until the sheep have been moved through or passed Obstacle 1. The Handler may move once the sheep clear Obstacle I or have passed it.
    - **HRDIII** Handlers will remain in the marked area through-out this exercise.
  4. **GATHER - 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep are behind the panels. The Dog will be called off the stock. Handler will position the Dog for the Gather from the area for their level. Send the Dog to gather the sheep. Move the sheep into the marked Handler's area then move the sheep into Field 3. Both Dog and Handler move into Field 3 before closing the gate. The exercise ends when the gate between Fields 3 and 5 is closed.
    - **HRD I** the Dog will be positioned no closer than the panels for Obstacle 1. The handle may move to within 15 ft. of the sheep and may accompany Dog and sheep as they are moved through the course.
    - **HRD II** the Dog will be positioned within the marked Handler's area. The Handler may move to Obstacle 1. Once the sheep have passed the Handler on the gather the Handler is free to move.
    - **HRD III** the Handler will remain at within the marked Handler's area throughout the gather.
  5. **REPEN HRD I & HRD II - 15 pts.; HRD III only - 25 pts:** Exercise begins when the gate into Field 3 is closed. Collect the sheep move them to the east side gate into 12 ft. alleyway into the Round Pen. Time ends when the gate to the Round Pen is closed.
    - **HRD III** - only will put the sheep through Obstacle 2.

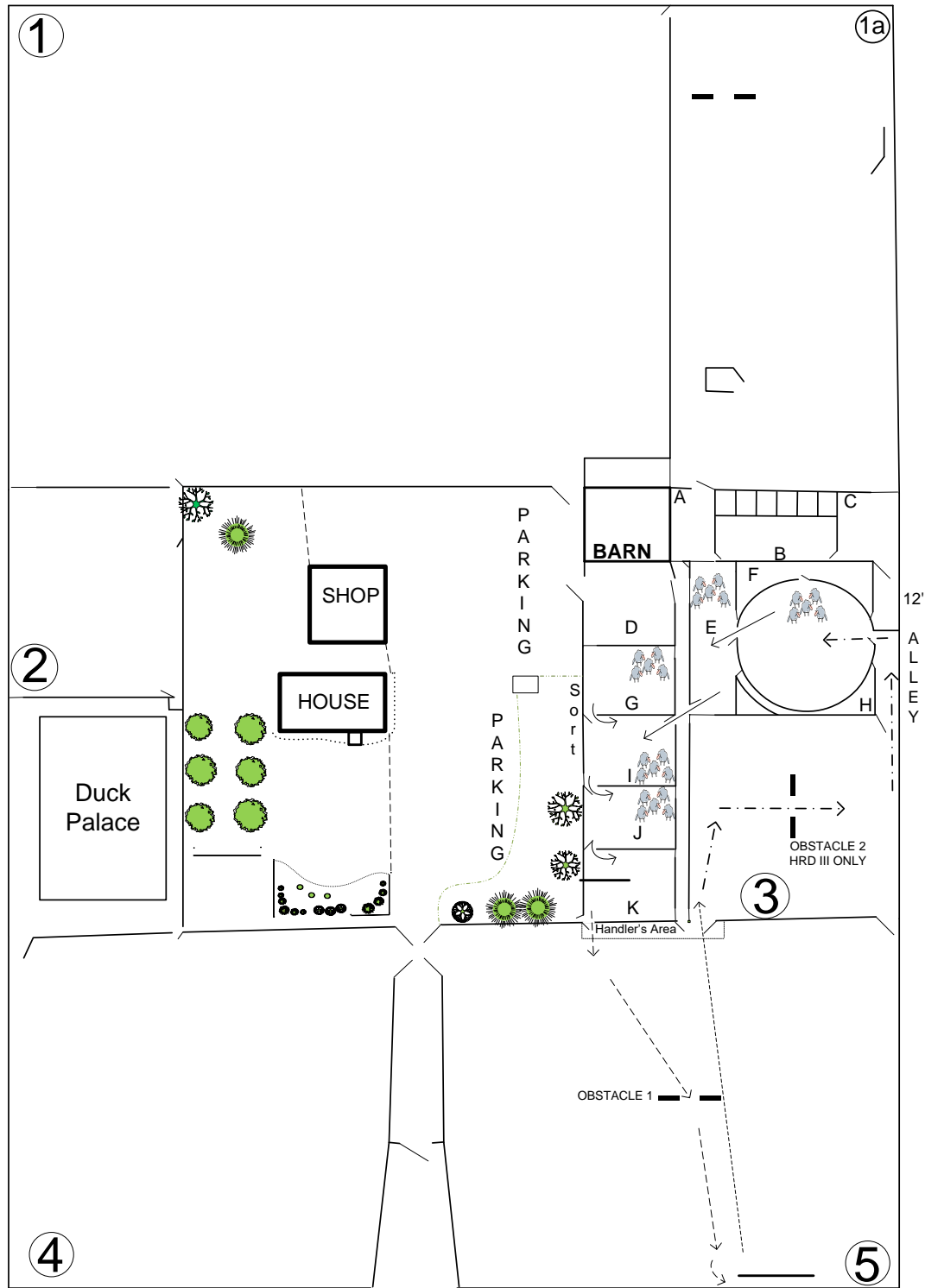
