Ducks will be for sale at conclusion of trials for \$5.00 a head.

**AWARDS: 4 SILVER BUCKLES:** High Combined WTCH Aussie, High Combined Non-WTCH Aussie, Most Promising Started Aussie and High Combined Other Breed. To be in the running for a buckle, only 6 scores required (2 cattle, 2 Sheep and 2 Ducks). For the MPSA buckle, all scores must be in the Started Division. Award for High Combined Junior. HIT prizes for Cattle, Sheep and Ducks in all 3 trials. Qualifying and placement ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> places.

**Pre-entries:** Ducks - \$30, Sheep - \$40, Cattle - \$50 Jr. Handler: ½ price each class

**Post-entry:** Ducks - \$35, Sheep - \$45, Cattle - \$55

**Pre-entries opening date:** Monday, July 9, 2018. (No entry will be accepted if postmarked prior to opening date).

**Pre-entries closing date:** Friday, August 3, 2018. (Any entry postmarked after closing date will be accepted at post-entry price if space is available).

Order of run will be determined prior to trial. Bitches in heat to run in order and must be crated when not competing. No refunds without a veterinary excuse. Entries will not be refunded after pre-entries close. You may substitute a dog you own, or co-own in its place. Replacement cost of stock will be current market value. Entries will be accepted as per ASCA Rules and must be filled out on an official ASCA entry form. Both can be found at [www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org). Day of entries will be accepted (if runs are available) from 7:00-7:30 am. Dogs not registered with ASCA must have a tracking number if they want to earn titles and have their Q's tracked.
