An official waiting list will be maintained. Random draw for run order will be made prior to the trial. If an owner pulls an entry, refunds will be made only if that space can be filled from the wait list. Refunds must be requested prior to the start of the trial. Bitches in season will run in draw order. Bitches in season will remain crated when not competing. All dogs must be on leash or crated when not competing. Please clean up after your dogs.
