## ENTRIES

**Runs limited:** 50 runs per trial all classes of stock combined.

### Pre-entries close (postmark): October 9

Entries postmarked after closing date will be taken at Day-of rate. Day-of entries will be taken if the trial is not full.

Post-dated checks and entries not accompanied with a check will not be accepted as a valid entry. Overnight entries are NOT necessary. Entries will be filled by Postmark Date Order. Do not mail entries requiring a signature for receipt.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The trial will be run and judged under ASCA rules as published in the most current rulebook. Run order will be drawn in advance. Bitches in season will run in order. All non-ASCA registered dogs must have an ASCA tracking number to receive ASCA titles. See <https://www.asca.org/> or call (979) 778-1082.

Dogs must be confined or on leash at all times when not working or in a designated exercise area. Individuals are responsible for any damage done to stock and/or facilities. Dogs that attack or maul any person, dog or livestock will be disqualified.

Stock replacement fee (injury is vet on-call fee): \$25 ducks, \$250 sheep, market value cattle.

**Concessions:** Coffee and bottled water will be available. Lunch will be available daily for a donation. Food is also available in Pinckney on M36.

## INDIVIDUAL TRIAL RIBBONS

- Qualifying ribbons as earned
- First through Fourth place ribbons for each division and class
- High Score Started, Open, and Advanced - Rosettes
- High Score Junior Handler and Novice Handler - Rosettes
- High in Trial Aussie - Rosette
- High in Trial Other Breed – Rosette

## SPECIAL WEEKEND ROSETTES

**High Combined WTCH Aussie:** highest combined score from all 4 trials on all classes of stock to the Aussie that begins the trial with the WTCH title.

**High Combined Non-WTCH Aussie:** highest combined score from all 4 trials on all classes of stock to the Aussie that begins the trials not having earned the WTCH title. Scores may be earned in the Open and/or Advanced divisions.

**High Combined Aussie Rosette and Jug Award:** highest combined score from all 4 trials. *Name plate for winning team will be added to trophy that will be maintained at a central location.*

**Most Promising Started Aussie:** calculated by using the two highest started scores from each class of stock in all 4 trials.

**High Combined Other Breed:** highest combined score over all 4 trials from any division on all classes of stock.

**High Combined Open Junior:** highest combined score over all 4 trials from any division (not including Novice Handler or Working Junior Handler) on all classes of stock.

**High Combined Junior Handler:** highest combined score over all 4 trials from the Junior Handler division on all classes of stock.

## DIRECTIONS

From US 23 exit at M36. Go west through Hamburg and Pinckney. 23.4 miles from US 23 turn right on Hinchey Road. A big power box is on the corner. The farm is 2.2 miles on the right. GPS may give alternate routes.

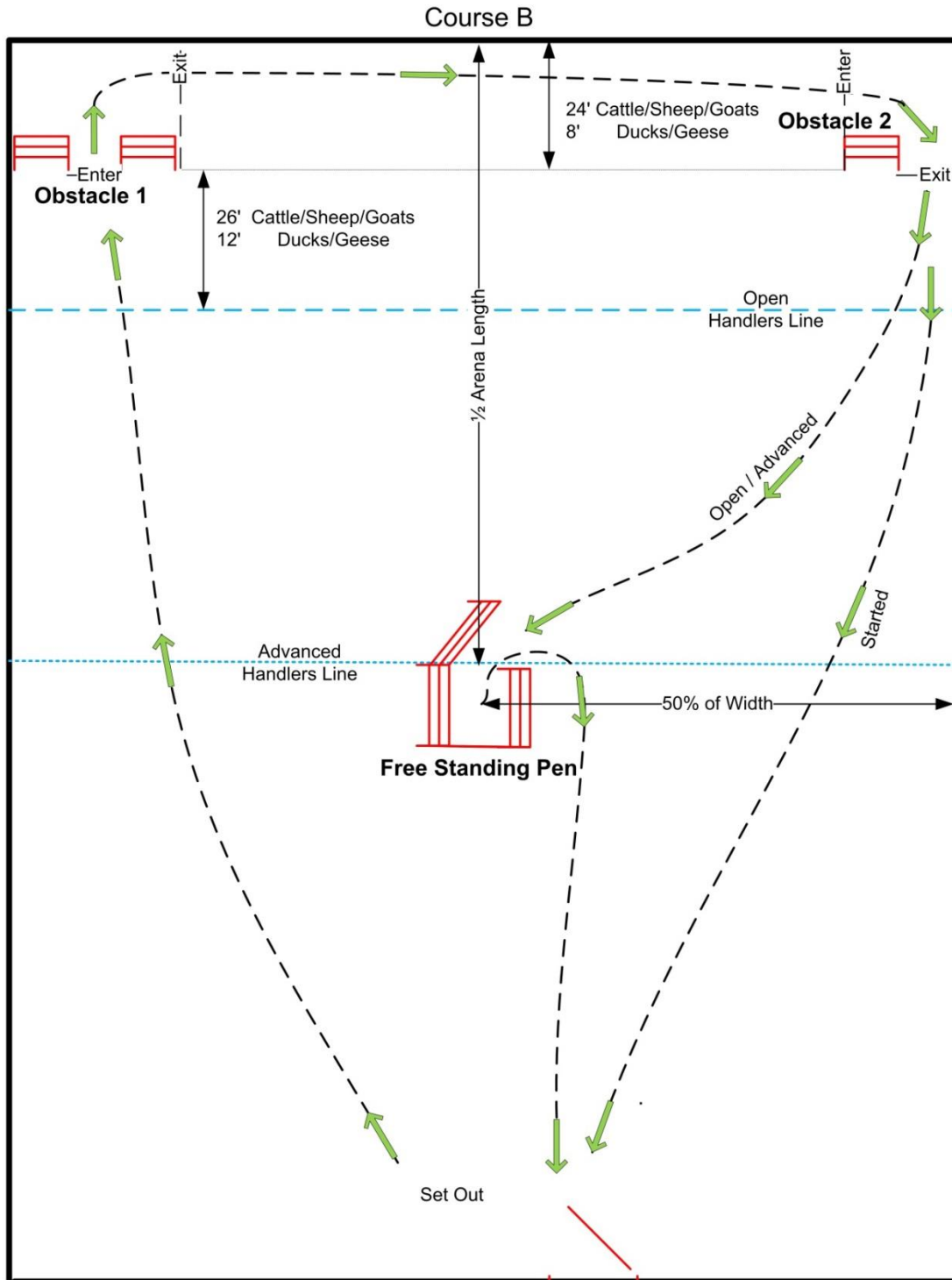

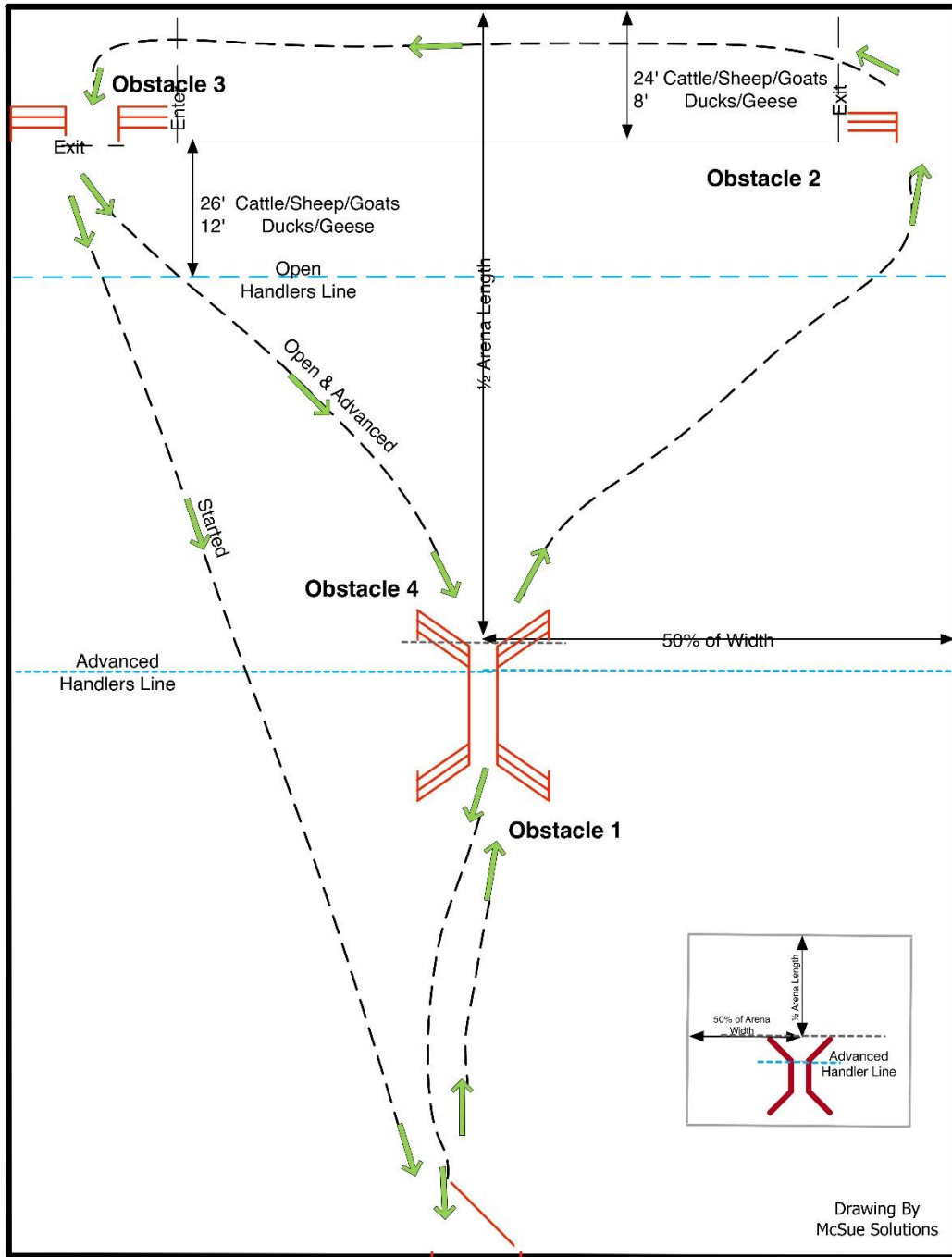
